## Policy No. 16 (Abbreviated) Policy on Public Hearings and Conduct at Public Meetings

# Public Hearing/Public Meeting

A public hearing is a formal opportunity for citizens to give their views to the Town Council for consideration in its decision making process on a specific issue. At a minimum, a public hearing shall provide for submission of both oral and written testimony for and against the action or matter at issue.

# Oral Communication

It is the Council's goal that citizens resolve their complaints for service or regarding employees' performance at the staff level. However, it is recognized that citizens may from time to time believe it is necessary to speak to Town Council on matters of concern. Accordingly, Town Council expects any citizen to speak in a civil manner, with due respect for the decorum of the meeting, and with due respect for all persons attending.

- No member of the public shall be heard until recognized by the presiding officer.
- Public comments related to non-agenda items will only be heard during the Public Comment portion of the meeting unless the issue is a Public Hearing. Public comments specifically related to an agenda item will be heard immediately prior to the Council taking up the item for deliberation.
- Speakers must state their name for the record.
- Any citizen requesting to speak shall limit him or herself to matters of fact regarding the issue of concern.
- Comments should be limited to three (3) minutes unless prior approval by the presiding officer.
- If a representative is elected to speak for a group, the presiding officer may approve an increased time allotment.
- If a response from the Council or Board is requested by the speaker and cannot be made verbally at the Council or Board meeting, the speaker's concerns should be addressed in writing within two weeks.
- Personal attacks made publicly toward any citizen, council member, or town employees are not allowed. Citizens are encouraged to bring their complaints regarding employee performance through the supervisory chain of command.

Any member of the public interrupting Town Council proceedings, approaching the dais without permission, otherwise creating a disturbance, or failing to abide by these rules of procedure in addressing Town Council, shall be deemed to have disrupted a public meeting and, at the direction of the presiding officer, shall be removed from the meeting room by Police Department personnel or other agent designated by Town Council or Operations Manager.

General Town Council Meeting Information

- Regular Town Council meetings are held at 7:00 PM on the first and third Tuesdays of each month at the West Yellowstone Town Hall, 440 Yellowstone Avenue, West Yellowstone, Montana.
- Presently, informal Town Council work sessions are held at 12 Noon on Tuesdays and occasionally on other mornings and evenings. Work sessions also take place at the Town Hall located at 440 Yellowstone Avenue.
- The schedule for Town Council meetings and work sessions is detailed on an agenda. The agenda is a list of business items to be considered at a meeting. Copies of agendas are available at the entrance to the meeting room.
- Agendas are published at least 48 hours prior to Town Council meetings and work sessions. Agendas are posted at the Town Offices and at the Post Office. In addition, agendas and packets are available online at the Town's website: www.townofwestyellowstone.com. Questions about the agenda may be directed to the Town Clerk at 646-7795.
- Official minutes of Town Council meetings are prepared and kept by the Town Clerk and are reviewed and approved by the Town Council. Copies of approved minutes are available at the Town Clerk's office or on the Town's website: www.townofwestyellowstone.com.

The meeting is called to order by Mayor Jerry Johnson 7:00 PM in the Town Hall, 440 Yellowstone Avenue, West Yellowstone, Montana.

The Treasurer's Report with corresponding banking transactions is on file at the Town Offices for public review during regular business hours.

### **Public Comment Period**

No public comments are received.

# **Council Comments**

Council Member Travis Watt announces that the annual community Thanksgiving dinner will be on November 19, 2020 at the LDS Church, COVID-style! He says the format will be carry-out or drive-through, masks and social distancing will be required. Greg Forsythe says that he talked to Drew Barney today about the ski festival during Thanksgiving week and says they are still trying to work out the details of that event this year due to the effects of the pandemic. Forsythe says that they have had a lot of changes in the Town recently and they need to put out the message that there is no way the snow removal this year is going to be as smooth as it has been in the past and ask people to be patient. He suggests Facebook or on the Town's website. Forsythe also suggests that following Town Council Meetings, they should put out a synopsis of what was decided at the meeting. He says maybe on Facebook or the Town's website, too. Johnson says that he agrees that snow removal is going to difficult at first until they get enough staff hired on and they need to communicate with the public. Johnson also congratulates the Watt family, a pacemaker was successfully put in their 6-year daughter last week and so far she is doing great. Council Member Schmier says that in light of the recent increase in COVID-19 cases in the area, perhaps they should put out a notice to remind everyone to take precautions. Johnson says they should remind everyone that they follow the recommendations put out by Gallatin County.

- 5) Motion carried to approve the request and claim for \$7500.00 to capitalize the revolving loan fund with the Northern Rocky Mountain Economic Development District. (Watt, Schmier)

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**Public Hearing: Resolution No. 749, Budget Amendment, Revolving Loan Fund Increase** Mayor Johnson reads the hearing notice. The hearing was advertised in the Bozeman Daily Chronicle on October 28, 2020 and November 3, 2020. The budget amendment allows the full expenditure of the CDBG fund balance. No public comments are received.

- 1) Johnson asks Finance Director Lanie Gospodarek about the Securities Report, which indicates that 97% of the Town's funds are invested in the same security. Gospodarek explains that is actually a group of securities held by Glacier Bank, but she will confirm that with the bank and get back to the Council with a better explanation.
- 2) Schmier asks about the claim to R & R Lock & Key to re-key the Trailhead Building. He also asks about the claim to Targhee Services and whether they have obtained a business license. He also asks about the claim to T & E Equipment for over \$11,089 and whether there were purchase orders approved ahead of time. Watt says that he has noticed that they are running over budget in several parts of the budget and they did discuss revisiting the budget halfway through the year to address that.
- 4) Mayor Johnson explains that Resolution No. 749 is a budget amendment. He says that the Town, through the Northern Rocky Mountain Economic Development District (NRMEDD), has obtained a grant to match the money the Town could put into a revolving loan fund for economic development that will be managed by NRMEDD.
- 5) Watt explains that he is on the committee that approved the request. He explains that the interest rate is 5% for this loan and it is a 5-year term. Watt says that they have representatives from both banks on the committee and they participated in the recommendation.
- A) The Department Head reports were sent out prior to the meeting and Town Manager Dan Sabolsky was not able to put one together because he is not feeling well. Forsythe asks Finance Director Lane Gospodarek if she believes all the major tax payments for September have been made. Gospodarek indicates that they do think they have paid.
